

Information on RoHS-compliant conversion to lead-free products

(EU RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU)

Dear Business Partner,

As part of the final phase-out of RoHS exemption 6c on 30 June 2027, ESCHA GmbH & Co. KG took comprehensive measures at an early stage to ensure a complete transition to lead-free materials. This will enable us to guarantee that our products will continue to be fully RoHS-compliant in the future.

Our conversion strategy

- Until 30 June 2026: Final purchases of raw materials covered by exemption 6c and containing leaded copper alloys above the limit value.
- From 1 January 2027: Delivery of all new customer orders completely lead-free – without invoking exemption 6c.
- Inventory management: Existing materials containing lead are used responsibly and gradually phased out in accordance with the applicable legal exemption. This ensures the resource-efficient and sustainable use of materials that have already been produced within the legal framework.
- New projects: Design is already carried out exclusively with lead-free materials.
